TRI-AREA INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN OFFICIALLY ADOPTED BY CYPRESS COUNTY, CITY OF MEDICINE HAT, AND TOWN OF REDCLIFF

DUNMORE, ALTA. – Cypress County is pleased to announce that the Tri-Area Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP) has now been formally adopted by the councils of Cypress County, the City of Medicine Hat, and the Town of Redcliff.

The Tri-Area IDP represents a collaborative effort between the three municipalities to coordinate long-term land use planning, foster responsible growth, and enhance regional cooperation in areas of mutual interest. This shared vision reflects the commitment of all parties to plan proactively and cooperatively for the future of the region.

While the IDP adoption marks a significant milestone, the municipalities are also jointly pursuing a boundary amendment to the current plan. This amendment aims to better reflect planning priorities and development realities within the region. The goal is to finalize and adopt this updated boundary by the end of June 2025.

"The adoption of the Tri-Area IDP highlights our continued dedication to regional collaboration and thoughtful planning," said Reeve Dan Hamilton. "We look forward to building on this foundation as we work with our neighbours in Medicine Hat and Redcliff on the forthcoming boundary amendment."
