1. CONDITIONS FOR QUOTE SUBMISSIONS

Bidders may submit quotations only up to 2:00 p.m. local time on June 4, 2025.

Bidders must submit quotations on the forms issued within this document.

It shall be the Bidder's responsibility to confirm with the County that its bid has been received prior to the quote closing.

When submitting a Quotation, all pages entitled "Quotation Forms", requested submittals, and all addenda issued by Cypress County, must be submitted, sealed in an envelope, addressed to Public Works Department at the above noted address marked "**Supply and Stockpile Sand**" with the time and date of Tender opening clearly marked on the lower right-hand corner of the envelope.

A bidder must indicate its name and address clearly in the upper left-hand corner of the envelope so that the Quote submission can be identified.

3. SCOPE OF QUOTATION

The purpose of this quotation is to select a Sand contractor to supply and stockpile sand at the Cypress County Yard inside Building "O." The contractor will be required to provide a conveyor at his cost to construct the stockpile inside the building enclosure.

4. SUBMISSION OF QUOTATIONS

4.1 Quotations will be accepted by Cypress County until 2:00 p.m. on June 4, 2025.

4.2 One (1) copy of the Quotation must be submitted.

- 4.3 It is the bidder's sole responsibility to ensure that the quotations are received at the correct place and time. Any bid received after the stated closing time for receipt of bids will be disqualified.
- 4.4 Any bidder requesting an extension in the closing date of the quotation must notify the Public Works Department, Cypress County, of the request 48 hours in advance of the closing date shown. An extension may be granted only by the Director of Public Works for good reason.
- 4.5 All inquiries are to be directed to Glenn Mattson, Municipal Foreman, Cypress County, phone (403) 526-2888.
- 4.6 The Bidder is to ensure all requested submittals at the time of bidding are included in the quote submission package. Failure to do so, may result in disqualification.

5. ACCEPTANCE AND WITHDRAWALS OF QUOTATIONS

- 5.1 Quotations must be signed by the person/persons submitting the quotation.
- 5.2 Quotations may be withdrawn at any time prior to the closing time by a request in writing to the Public Works Department.
- 5.3 Quotations shall not be withdrawn after the closing time. Negligence or mistake on the part of the Bidder in preparing the quotation confers no right for withdrawal of the bid after closing time.
- 5.4 Modifications in bids will only be considered when submitted in writing in a sealed envelope clearly marked Winter Sand Supply Quotation, and providing such changes are received at the Cypress County Administration Building (front counter), prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.
- 5.5 Cypress County reserves the right at its sole option, to reject any and all Quotations, or any or all portions of a Quotation.
- 5.6 The lowest bid or any other quotation will not necessarily be accepted.
- 5.7 Cypress County reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to waive any irregularities in a quotation.

6. GUARANTEE

- 6.1 Prices are to be valid for a period of 30 days after the Quotation closing time to allow for evaluation of bids and award of the contract.
- Pricing must be in Canadian Funds, and shall include all duties and taxes, (other than the Goods and Services Tax), including Customs duties, Excise duties, brokerage charges, and all other taxes and charges applicable with respect to the RFQ, unless otherwise specifically stipulated.

7. THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT

7.1 All documents submitted to the County will be subject to the protection and disclosure provisions of Alberta's Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act ("FOIP"). FOIP allows persons a right of access to records in the County's custody or control. It also prohibits the County from disclosing the bidder's personal or business information where disclosure would be harmful to the bidder's business interests or would be an unreasonable invasion of personal privacy as defined in sections 16 and 17 of FOIP. Bidders are encouraged to identify what portions of their submissions are confidential and what harm could reasonably be expected from its disclosure. However, the County cannot assure bidders that any portion of the bidder's documents can be kept confidential under FOIP.

8. LAW AND FORUM OF TENDER

8.1 The law to be applied in respect of the Quotation Documents and the Contract shall be the law of the Province of Alberta and all civil actions commenced in relation to the Quotation Documents or Contract shall be adjudicated by the Courts of the Province of Alberta and by submitting Quotes, bidders are taken to have agreed to attorn to the jurisdiction of the Courts of the said Province.

9. SCOPE OF WORK: SUPPLY AND STOCKPILE SAND

- 9.1 Cypress County (the County) will pay the awarded Contractor the applicable unit bid price per tonne, weighed by a certified scale, for the specified bid item ordered.
- 9.2 Progress payments may be made with supporting documentation of the work completed to date from the bidder. All payments will be subject to a 10% holdback.
- 9.3 Holdback monies will be paid out 45 days after the work is satisfactorily completed and accepted by Cypress County.
- 9.4 Bidders will NOT include any amount in the bid price for Goods and Services Tax. The GST will be billed by the successful bidder as a separate item in addition to the contract amount.
- 9.5 The Agreement period will be for the Supply and Stockpiling of Sand 2025, 2026 and 2027, with an option to renew annually at an agreed upon rate, subject to mutual agreement by both parties.
- 9.6 The Contractor shall supply 5mm Manufactured Fines.
- 9.7 The contractor shall supply sand in accordance with Specification 3.2 Aggregate Production and Stockpiling and produce sand to the following gradation:

The contractor may be permitted to supply material of differing gradation characteristics providing the source and gradation will in the opinion of the County achieve the desired result.

- 9.8 The contractor is to supply a sample (2 5 Gallon Pails) of the sanding material prior to hauling to the yard for visual inspection as well as provide production sieve analysis test to confirm the material meets specification. Cypress County reserves the right to perform quality assurance testing as it deems necessary at no cost to the contractor once delivered to the yard. If Cypress County deems that the material does not meet specifications it reserves the right to reject the said material.
- 9.9 Cypress County requires delivery of Sand as specified to the Public Works Yard Building "O" 737 2nd Avenue, Dunmore, Alberta, which includes stacking in the sand shed.



- 9.10 Inspection by Cypress County of advance samples shall not constitute final acceptance, and the Contractor will remain bound by any warranties set out in the specification requirements.
- 9.11 The bidder is required to provide certified true copies of proof in the submission package that they:
 - 9.11.1 maintain Automobile Liability Insurance in an amount not less than \$2,000,000 on all vehicles owned, operated, or licensed in the name of the Operator
 - 9.11.2 maintain General Liability Insurance in an amount not less than \$5,000,000
 - 9.11.3 maintain a Safety Manual in compliance with Occupational Health and Safety legislation (COR, or equivalent)
 - 9.11.4 WCB Letter of Account in Good Standing
- 9.12 Any cost incurred by the bidder in the preparation or submission of documents pertaining to the RFQ will be borne solely by the bidder. By submitting a Quotation, the bidder agrees that it will not claim damages, for whatever reason, relating to the RFQ or in respect of the competitive process.
- 9.13 No work shall be performed until the Agreement has been executed by both parties.
