MAINTENANCE OF DEVELOPED ROADS TO RESIDENCES

Policy Statement

Cypress County is responsible to ensure public roads under its control and management are kept in a reasonable state of repair.

The County will maintain dead end roads to permanent residences, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The road must be developed on a public right-of-way or within a registered road plan.
- The road must be developed to a "High Grade" standard as determined by current construction engineered standards or policy on construction of roads. Roads regularly maintained (blading, grading, plowing, mowing) as of July 5, 2016 will be treated like "High Grade" under this policy.
- 3. The residence must be occupied on a permanent, year round basis.
- 4. The County will decide the level and frequency of maintenance.
- 5. Any resident whose residential access does not meet this policy, may appeal in writing to Council for regular maintenance.
