MAINTENANCE ACCESSES

Purpose

To provide maintenance to occupied residential private driveways and farm access roads within Cypress County.

Guidelines

- 1. Landowners who want to have their private driveways or farm access roads maintained by the County must complete an Agreement for Maintenance of Private Driveways & Farm Access Roads, prior to maintenance being performed.
- 2. The Policy will be applicable for both summer and winter maintenance requests.
- 3. Maintenance requests of private driveways or farm access roads will be accepted upon the understanding that these works will be undertaken after satisfactory completion of County roads in that area and a local grader is available.
- 4. Applicants will be invoiced each time maintenance is completed.
- 5. Landowners with delinquent invoices after 60 days will have their Maintenance Agreement terminated.
- 6. Charges for the maintenance work will be set by Council in the Master Rates Bylaw.
- 7. The County shall have the right to refuse to maintain any private driveway or farm access road which is impractical, hazardous, or unsafe.
- 8. Hamlets or multi-parcel Country Residential Subdivisions are not eligible for maintenance of private driveways.
