SIGN UP TO PAY YOUR TAXES IN MONTHLY INSTALLMENTS

WHAT IS TIPP?

TIPP is the Tax Installment Payment Plan by which taxpayers pay their property taxes in monthly installments by pre-authorized transfer of funds from their bank account, rather than one single tax payment.

WHY SHOULD I USE TIPP?

- TIPP divides the annual tax payment into 12 equal monthly payments to make budgeting easier
- Regular payments are assured. If you are on vacation, out of town on business or sick, your payment will be made on time and automatically
- Convenient and reliable method of ensuring that your tax bill is paid and always remains current

WHO CAN USE TIPP?

All taxpayers are eligible providing all previous year's taxes are paid in full

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Payments start on January 1st of each year and are made on the first of every month thereafter
- Monthly payments from January June shall be calculated as 1/12 of the prior year tax levy, adjusted for any estimated future tax or assessment changes
- Monthly payments from July December shall be calculated as 1/6 of the outstanding balance for the current year being the difference of payments received and the actual current year's levy
- Once you are on TIPP, you will be automatically renewed on the plan each year

WHEN CAN I APPLY FOR TIPP?

You can apply for TIPP at any time. If your application is received after January 1st of the current year, you will be required to make an initial payment representing the installments that would have been made since the beginning of the year

HOW DO YOU APPLY FOR TIPP?

To apply for TIPP, complete and sign the pre-authorized debit application form, attach a void cheque, and return it to the Cypress County office or email the completed documents to tipp@cypress.ab.ca.

WITHDRAWL OR CANCELLATION

You may withdraw from TIPP by submitting the TIPP Cancellation Form not less than 14 days before the next payment date. If any monthly payments are missed, the County has the option to cancel the TIPP agreement. If you withdraw or the County cancels your TIPP agreement, all unpaid taxes become due and payable and are subject to penalties in accordance with the Tax Penalties Bylaw. Any payments made that are dishonored by the bank are subject to a \$25.00 service charge
