Purpose

To determine a reasonable and open competitive Request for Tender process to hire, sustain the availability of and regulate rates of contract gravel trucks required for the annual road graveling program in Cypress County.

Guidelines

1. Any person or company who is a registered owner of a combination truck and trailer equipped for road graveling, registered to operate in the Province of Alberta may apply through the public tender call for contract gravel trucks.
2. If there are several individual contract trucks selected in the request for tender process, the County will create a call list on a first call bases for the graveling season based on performance, reliability and bid outcome.
3. The tender will require contract gravel truck operators to provide certified true copies of the following documentation:
 - 3.1. ownership with Alberta Government Registration and Certification;
 - 3.2. insurance with valid insurance policy showing a minimum of \$5,000,000 coverage for public liability and property damage; and
 - 3.3. Workers Compensation Board coverage with active account number.
4. Contract gravel truck haul rates₂ will be set through the tender process. Rates will be set at tender price established by formula of [Tonnes/Per km]
5. Out of scope work will be determined by the Master Rates Bylaw set by Alberta Road Builders Rates.
