DUNMORE — Cypress County is thrilled with the [Government of Alberta's decision to include upgrades to Highway 41 South](#) along with continued support for the twinning of Highway 3 in its list of capital projects.

Premier Danielle Smith announced that 55 kilometres of Highway 41 South is earmarked for widening as part of the provincial budget.
